Interpreting Monday – Friday 8am -5pm	\$100.00 per hour (charged as a whole or part thereof)
Minimum call out, Video or phone link	3 hours
Minimum call out fee	\$300.00
Full Day Rate (8 hours)	\$800.00
<b>After Hours Loading</b>	
Monday to Friday 5pm – 8pm And All-Day Saturday – 50%	\$150.00 per hour (Min 3 hour) \$450.00 (minimum)
Every Day after 8.00pm to 8.00 am, All day, Sunday/Public Holiday – 100%	\$200.00 per hour (Min 3 hours) \$600.00 (Min)
